

BY-LAW NO. 09-27

- of -

THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF SPRINGFIELD

Being a by-law of the Rural Municipality of Springfield to establish a revised ward system for the purpose of electing municipal Councillors.

WHEREAS subsection 87 (1) of the Municipal Act being C.56 SM 1996 provides as follows:-

"87 (1) Every member of a Council is to be elected by a vote of the electors of the whole municipality unless the Council by By-Law provides that the Councillors are to be elected on the basis of wards."

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary and desirable to establish a ward system to elect councilors in the Rural Municipality of Springfield;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the council of the Rural Municipality of Springfield enacts as follows:

1. That the Rural Municipality of Springfield be divided into four (4) wards, as per attached schedule "A".
2. That each ward be represented by one (1) member of council within each ward.
3. That the four wards be numbered numerically from 1 to 4 respectively as shown on Schedule "A" to this by-law.
4. That By-law No. 01-17 be rescinded.
5. That this by-law take effect at the next general election scheduled for October 2010.

Done and passed as a By-Law of the Rural Municipality of Springfield at Oakbank in the Province of Manitoba this 6th day of January A.D. 2010.
