I/We hereby undertake, acknowledge and agree:

- 1. all work or activity conducted on the premises in connection with the home occupation will be carried on entirely within the residential dwelling unit situated on the land or entirely within a building accessory to that dwelling unit;
2. that the home occupation referred to herein will be conducted solely by one or more of the residents living in the residential dwelling unit situated on the premises without the employment of any other person;
3. there shall be no exterior indication of the existence or operation of the home occupation and without limiting the generality of such prohibition, there shall be no exterior display, no interior display visible from the outside and no exterior storage of goods or materials associated with the home occupation;
4. articles sold on the premises shall be limited to those produced thereon;
5. no work or service will be conducted as a home occupation which may be offensive, obnoxious, a nuisance or cause undue generation of traffic and/or congestion in the neighbourhood and the surrounding area;
6. any exterior advertising sign for a home occupation must be approved by the Development Officer and/or Council. (Site plan of location of sign and design and size of sign to be submitted with application);
7. a business license may be revoked at any time, if any infractions occur.
