

5 WAYS TO PAY

Please note: Credit cards are not accepted for property tax or utility payments.



1. PAY BY PHONE/INTERNET

Most financial institutions offer pay-by-phone services or on-line banking. Call your branch for details

Please use your Property Tax Roll number or Utility Account number for bill payment. (enter all digits except the decimal point)



2. PAY BY MAIL

Insert your payment (cheque or money order), add postage and mail. Please make reference of your tax or utility account number.



3. 24 HOUR DROP OFF

Drop your payment in the mail slot located at the front entrance of the Administration office.



4. PAY IN PERSON

Bring your bill payment to the Administration Office between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Payment options include cheque, cash and Interac.

Property Tax Payments: Post dated cheques will be accepted. Oakbank Credit Union will accept TAX payments only during the month of October.



5. TAX INSTALLMENT PAYMENT PLAN (T.I.P.P.)

Monthly payments will be withdrawn from your financial institution until your tax account is fully paid.
